

Bude RATs Awards Scheme Rules

Scheme 1 - Full Colours Awards Race Standards (by age category)

1. The Award Scheme qualifying period will run from April 1st to March 31st, i.e. Bude RATs membership year.
2. Each Members Award Scheme age category will be determined by their age on April 1st of that qualifying period.
3. To qualify for an award standard, members need to achieve their age category time in a minimum of three different race distances within the qualifying period.
4. Members can enter as many events during the qualifying period as they like. Only the fastest time for each race distance will count.
5. Only properly measured, certified races with published race results count and the times used by the scheme will be the official race time.
6. Awards will be given for a member's best three race distances. The lowest standard of the three will determine the award, i.e. a Gold 10k, Silver 10mile & Bronze Half Marathon will result in a Bronze Award for that period.
7. Members can only receive one award per qualifying period i.e. three Silver standard events and a further three Bronze standard events would only qualify for one Silver award.
8. All Bude RATs senior and student members are automatically included in the Awards Scheme.
9. A special award will be given to members who achieve a standard in the most race distances within a qualifying period.
- 10. The Award Scheme Co-ordinator will endeavour to locate all race times. However, it will remain the responsibility of each member to ensure that their times have been recorded in the scheme. Email to info@buderats.co.uk**
11. Progress will be published on the Bude RATs website each month.
12. Awards will be presented at the Bude RATs Awards & Social Night each March.
